We are honoured to invite you to take part in the International Neuropsychological Society (INS) meeting at the Jagiellonian University in Krakow, Poland (June 30 – July 03 2010).

The INS Conferences usually gather 700-1000 participants from all over the world. They represent researchers and clinicians interested in brain-behaviour relationships including the disciplines of clinical and experimental neuropsychology, cognitive psychology, neurolinguistics, neuropsychiatry, neurobiology, and rehabilitation.

The scientific framework is being prepared by Prof. Anna Grabowska from the Polish Academy of Sciences (co-director of the Scientific Board of the Conference from the Polish side), Prof. Peter Arnett from Penn State University (co-director of the Scientific Board representing the INS) and Prof. Stephen Rao from Schey Center for Cognitive Neuroimaging (The President Elect of the INS).

The INS Krakow meeting will encompass invited lectures by leading scientists and clinicians, as well as oral sessions and symposia and poster sessions. In addition to the scientific program there also will be continuing education workshops. Conference Abstracts will be published in the online Journal of the International Neuropsychological Society.
