



Memorandum of Understanding
between
The International Neuropsychological Society
and
The Federation of European Societies of Neuropsychology

The International Neuropsychological Society (INS) and the Federation of European Societies of Neuropsychology (FESN) agree as follows:

The Bylaws of INS and the Constitution of the FESN share mutual objectives calling for the advancement of the discipline in the public interest, which includes both organizations' emphasis on multidisciplinary membership and the importance of their scientific, clinical, and educational missions.

Both organizations express the intention to collaborate on a voluntary basis by sharing information, providing expertise, giving mutual support, and developing joint action in the areas of common interest.

Mutual concerns make it likely that occasions for joint consultation and cooperation will present themselves in the years to come, and both organizations wish to anticipate such occasions by establishing a framework, when possible, for their timely discussion.

Therefore, INS and FESN affirm and reaffirm their working relations in this Memorandum of Understanding.

Furthermore, pursuant to this Memorandum of Understanding, the executives of INS and FESN shall maintain regular communication to discuss matters of common concern.

Finally, INS and FESN will seek to identify projects and activities in which they may work together, assist or support one another, or otherwise cooperate for the betterment of Neuropsychology in the public interest.
